Why the change in assessment?

That hurt our kids who need to be competitive with others across the country and hurt our teachers by making it difficult for them to have a true picture of the academic strengths and weakness of their students."

Key Instructional Shifts Georgia Standards of Excellence


ELA

- Regular practice with complex texts and their academic language
- Reading, writing and speaking grounded in evidence text
- Building knowledge through content rich nonfiction

Mathematics

- Greater focus on fewer topics
- Coherence: Linking topic and thinking's across grades
- Rigor: Pursue conceptual understanding, procedural skills and fluency, and application with equal intensity

Assessment Shifts



- Alignment with Georgia Standards of Excellence
 - Designed to encourage critical thinking, analytical writing and real-world problem solving
- Fewer multiple choice questions
 - Increase in short-answers (constructed response) and extended responses that require students to demonstrate a deeper understanding of key concepts





- Paper-pencil GMAS will be available for the <u>small</u> number of students who cannot interact with computer due to their disability






(Percent of Students in Each Performance Level)




Math(Percent of Students in Each Performance Level)





(Percent of Students in Each Performance Level)




Social Studies
Percent of Students in Each Performance Level)




GRADE 3 BASELINE GA MILESTONES DATA





GRADE 4 GA MILESTONES BASELINE DATA




GRADE 5 GA MILESTONES BASELINE DATA





A Note About National Percentiles

- -Each Georgia Milestones assessment includes a subset of 20 items from the TerraNova, a norm-referenced achievement test.
- -This type of standardized assessment allows for the interpretation of the test score in relation to others of the same grade and age.
- -All 20 TerraNova items contribute to a student's normreferenced score (National Percentile).
- -Only those TerraNova items (10 or fewer items depending on the specific EOG assessment) that align to state content standards were actually included in the Milestone score.




